

10 Quick Fixes

Please see below the details of the summer tasks that have been set by your teachers. It is really important that you complete the activities for your subjects so that you can make the best possible start to Year 11 and you are fully prepared for your next trial exam cycle which starts on the 7th October 2024.

English Language

Practice and perfect your narrative for C1 Section B.

You need to learn the five-part plan for your own narrative. The exam board wants to see how imaginative you can be and that you can adapt your tone, style and vocabulary. You will need to organise ideas into coherent paragraphs and use sentences for clarity, purpose and effect, with accurate spelling and punctuation.

Plan it again from memory and rewrite it. Then spend time recrafting each sentence and then each paragraph. Ask someone at home to read it- perhaps they can help you to add little details or improved word choices.

English Literature

Complete GCSE Pods set on: 'An Inspector Calls', 'Macbeth' and 'A Christmas Carol'.

Learn the key quotations for Literature. Your teacher has given you a handout and this is also on Teams. If you wish to learn some different ones of your own choice as well, then that is great!
